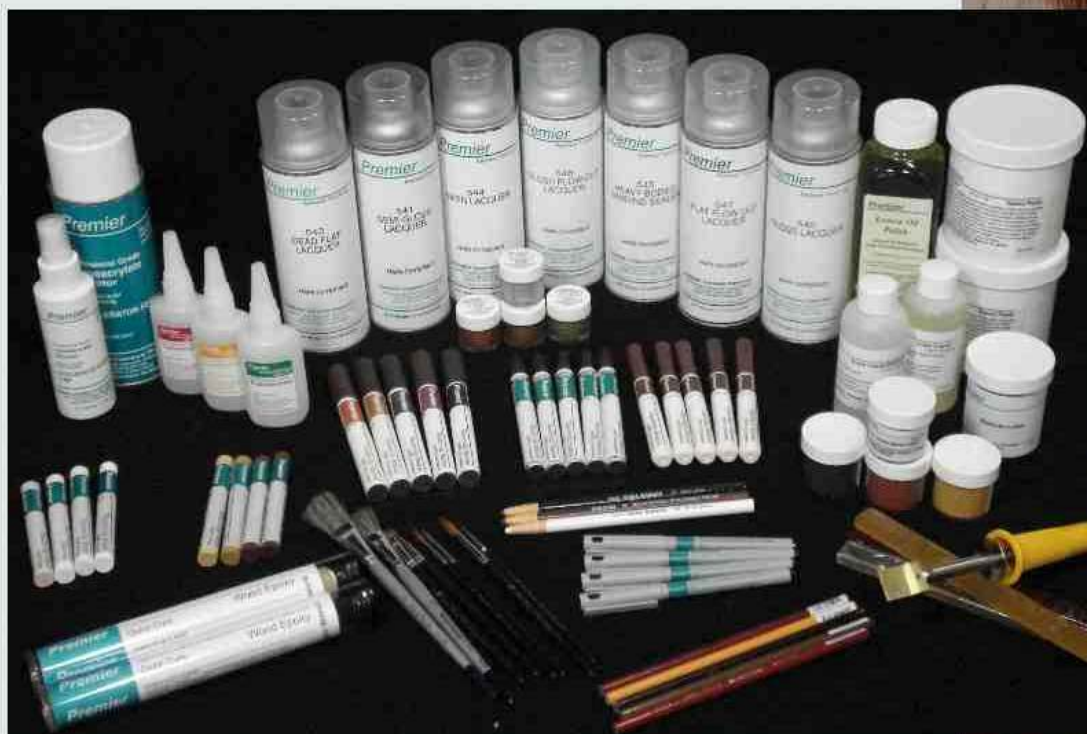

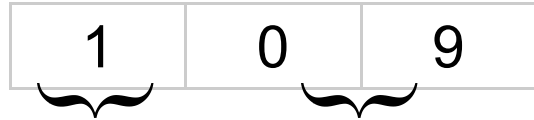

Our product numbering system was designed to make it very easy for the customer to determine the right product to use. In the wood tones, as the numbers increase the color gets darker.

Lower numbers = lighter colors

Higher numbers = darker colors



1st digit = series

Example:

1=100 series=touch-up sticks

2=200series = touch-up markers

3=300 Series= capillary marker  
etc

-The last two digits are the  
color number

-Wood tones are numbered  
from 01 to 37

-Whites, off-whites & greys are  
numbered from 81 to 92

X09=Light Oak

109=Light Oak Touch-up Stick

209=Light Oak Touch-up Marker

309=Light Oak Capillary Marker

809=Light Oak Burn-in Stick


